Transfer Agreement  
Bushnell University and Mt. Hood Community College**

This letter of agreement has been enacted to facilitate the transfer of students from Mt. Hood Community College (MHCC) with a(n) Associate of Applied Science degree in Nursing to Bushnell University (Bushnell). Specific pathways have been mutually agreed upon for the RN to BSN program. The attached list reflects mutually agreed upon course articulations. The agreement is to be enacted for Bushnell's 2022-23 academic year and to remain in effect for five years (through the 2027-28 academic year). Annual reviews of the curriculum for both institutions may necessitate mutually agreed upon updates to the transfer agreement. These updates will be documented and reaffirmed each summer until such time as (a) the agreement is mutually abandoned, (b) the 5-year timeframe elapses, or (c) a new agreement is formally approved by MHCC and Bushnell either replacing or extending the agreement. Students who transfer to Bushnell University will meet Biblical studies requirements through the RN to BSN major.

As part of this letter of agreement, Bushnell University will provide MHCC students with assistance in the preparation and transfer of institutional credit, prior learning experience credit, military credit, and CLEP exam credit. In order to facilitate transfer between the two institutions, students are urged to meet with Bushnell admissions personnel well before transferring so as to ensure the most complete assessment of all relevant credits. Students wishing to participate in this transfer agreement must send an official transcript of all previous coursework and complete the Bushnell admissions process.

Bushnell University pledges to publish in its catalog the name of Mt. Hood Community College and on its website the pathways that have been currently agreed upon by both institutions. Bushnell also pledges to continue working with MHCC to refine existing articulations, as well as explore additional articulation pathways.

Graduates of MHCC's AAS Nursing program who meet the admission requirements for Bushnell's RN to BSN program will be granted admission. Current admission requirements are listed on the Bushnell School of Nursing website.

## **General Education Requirements for the BSN & MHCC Approved Courses**

### 1. Writing: minimum 5 semester credits (7.5 quarter credits)

WR 121 English Composition *Met with WR 121 at MHCC*

WR 123 English Composition: Research *Met with WR 122 at MHCC*

### 2. Humanities: 15 semester credits (22.5 quarter credits)

One communications course *Met with NRS 110B 230, 111B, 231, 232, 233 at MHCC*

One philosophy course *Met with NRS 111A at MHCC*

One literature course *Met with any ENG course at MHCC*

One history course *Met with any HST course at LCC*

Additional humanities *Any course at the 100 level or above in foreign language or with the prefix COMM, ENG, FA, HUM, HST, R*

### 3. Social Sciences: 15 semester credits (22.5 quarter credits)

*Met with PSY 237 and NRS courses from the AAS Nursing program.*

### 4. Math, Science, Computer: minimum 6 semester credits (9 quarter credits)

Math 105 or higher *Met with MTH 105 or higher at MHCC*

*Note: Statistics is not required.*

One science with a lab *Met with BI prerequisites for the AAS Nursing program*

Computer science\* *Met with any CIS or CS course at MHCC*

*\*A free test-out option is also available.*

## 5. Electives

*Any 100 or 200-level courses from MHCC can be transferred toward electives. Students are encouraged to meet with a Bushnell advisor to determine if additional electives are needed.*

## 6. Bible & Christian Ministry Studies: 8 semester credits

*Met in the BSN major. No additional coursework required.*

## 7. Diversity Studies

*Met with NRS 111A at MHCC.*

### **Additional Transfer Credit Options and Limitations**

- All general education requirements except Biblical Studies and electives can alternatively be met with an associate of arts Oregon transfer (AAOT) degree.
- Students must earn a C- grade or better for MHCC coursework to transfer.
- DPSST, military, and other police/fire training as recommended by the American Council on Education: no maximum, but credits must meet degree requirements.
- College Level Examination Program (CLEP) and Advanced Placement: no maximum; all accepted credits must meet degree requirements.
- Vocational/technical courses: no maximum; all accepted credits must meet degree requirements.
- PE and music performance credits: 8 semester (12 quarter) credits maximum. No more than two classes with the same course number will be accepted.
- Developmental courses (generally less than 100 level) do not transfer.
