TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN Mt. Hood Community College and Colby-Sawyer College

Colby-Sawyer College (CSC) and Mt. Hood Community College (MHCC) support the joint goal to work collaboratively to assist students to pursue the following on-line Bachelor completion programs:

- RN to BS in Nursing
- RRT to BS in Respiratory Therapy
- BS in Health Studies

Therefore, CSC hereby agrees to offer admission to graduates of MHCC who have completed the requirements for an Associate Degree with:

- a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 on a four-point scale
- a minimum of sixty credits, with a minimum grade of "C" in each course
- required licensure for RN to BS and RRT to BS programs

A. Transfer Pathways:

Completion of the associate degree from MHCC will satisfy many of each program's requirements at CSC. Equivalent courses taken at MHCC will satisfy the parallel requirements at CSC, as per the transfer pathways agreed upon by CSC and MHCC.

The minimum number of total credits required for baccalaureate graduation at CSC is 120 credits. The minimum number of credits that must be taken at CSC for baccalaureate graduation is 30 credits. All degree requirements must be satisfied in order to receive a degree from CSC, as detailed in the College Catalog.

Any student who wishes to transfer under the terms of this agreement must provide CSC with a current official transcript of academic work from MHCC or any other college/university where coursework was completed.

B. Conditional Admission:

Students who are in their final semester (minimum 45 credits) and meet the grade point average of 2.0 would be a conditional admit to the program, pending submission of Associate Degree transcripts and any required licensure.

C. Tuition Costs:

Students who are accepted to CSC under the terms of this agreement are eligible for a preferred tuition of \$270/credit plus \$10/credit online course fee.

D. Financial Aid Opportunities:

Students who are accepted to CSC under the terms of this agreement are eligible for financial aid. Other financial aid opportunities, both federal and institutional, may be available. The CSC Admissions Office can provide additional information.
