You will also be asked to do some sight reading, singing of scales, singing back of rhythmic and melodic lines, and possible scat.

Auditions are based on: attitude, work ethic, talent, and teacher recommendation.

The Mt Hood Community College music department is in its 42nd year of developing world class musicians. Mt. Hood music students have gone on to perform with such greats as Maynard

Ferguson, Woody Herman, Stan Kenton, Buddy Rich, Mel Tormé, Herbie Hancock, Diana Ross, Frank Sinatra, George Shearing, Liza Minelli, Harry Connick Jr., Diana Krall, Wynton Marsalis, the best Las Vegas show rooms, the best cruise ships and over 25 of the world's major symphony orchestras- not to mention the scores of students that have gone on to become the finest music teachers this country has to offer.

The Mt. Hood Community College vocal jazz ensemble, GENESIS, is in its 41st year of

outstanding jazz performance. Being the original pioneer in vocal jazz education, they have accepted invitations to be the featured group at many jazz festivals and conventions from coast to coast and have won many awards and over the years, including prestigious "db" Awards from Downbeat Magazine and the college sweepstakes at the Lionel Hampton and Gene Harris Jazz Festivals. In 2007, Genesis traveled to NYC to make their 7<sup>th</sup> appearance at an IAJE international jazz conference. The group has many CDs available, including their current CD "Do You Miss New York".

### About the director...



Dave Barduhn is in his 20<sup>th</sup> year of teaching at Mt. Hood Community College. As a performer Dave has played piano with Mark Murphy, Diane Shuur, Diane Reeves, Ernie Andrews and several Stan Kenton Alumni Bands.

He is better known for his jazz arranging for Stan Kenton, Bud Shank, Bobby Shew, Richie Cole, The Four Freshman, and especially Jenson Publications. His groups have performed at many IAJE National Conventions, MENC Conventions, and ACDA Conventions. As director of the pioneering vocal jazz group Genesis, Dave and his students have won many awards from Downbeat magazine, the IAJE Journal, and most of the more prestigious jazz festivals in the West.

Dave is now on parole after serving a 20 year sentence with the Frank DeMeiro jazz camp and is now a founding staff member of the new Soundsation Jazz camp. In 2006. Dave performed the role of Tevye in "Fiddler On The Roof". In 2006 Dave will served as the guest conductor for the British Columbia Honor Jazz Choir and Genesis traveled to NYC to make their 7<sup>th</sup> appearance at an IAJE national convention

Cost	Price	Explanation
Mt Hood Community College Tuition	\$2376	Based on enrollment for 12 credits per term for 3 terms. (\$66 per credit) Tuition does not include room, board or books.
Genesis Fee	\$525	Includes retreat fee, outfit fee, all travel within the Pacific Northwest. This is collected as a \$175 per term fee when you register.
Private lessons	\$750	Approximately \$25 each lesson, x 10 half hour sessions per term, x 3 terms
Total cost (for FAF purposes)	\$3651	Based on enrollment for 15 credits per term for 3 terms.

\*No additional out of state charges for residents of California, Idaho, Nevada and Washington.

**Scholarships** - Your best bet is through the Federal government. Filling out your FAF forms ASAP could mean access to Pell Grants, GSL loans or College work-study funds. Ideally FAF forms should be filled out and sent in February or March. Genesis has approximately 6 tuition waivers to award for talent. With an average of over 22 students in the group each year, those 6 waivers don't go very far. In addition, anything I give you will be subtracted from whatever the feds give you. So I'd rather have Hillary and the boys give it to you!!

**Performances** - We do between 30 and 50 performances a year. We schedule them so that you never miss more than 3 class days in any one-quarter (on average). You are expected to make up all work missed. In other words, we expect you to be serious students as well as great musicians!!

**Housing** - We do not have dorms - nor the exorbitant costs that dorms and their restrictive meal packages can cost. We do have many reasonably priced apartment complexes within walking distance of the campus. Housing information is available from the counseling office.
