

Pass-Through Referral Paperwork

(Obtaining a referral is at the discretion of each high school and may not be granted. Students under 18 must get a release if a referral is denied.)

All students 16-20 must go to the school in order to get a referral. A release may be obtained if a referral request is denied. Students under 18 must have a parent or legal guardian to sign referral/release forms.

Centennial/Centennial Park (Melissa Donnini 503-298-5401): Students should go to the school they were last attending to ask for a referral. A release may be obtained if a referral request is denied. Students under 18 must have a parent or legal guardian to sign referral/release forms.

Corbett (Jeannie Swift 503-261-4235): Students must go to the school in order to get a referral. A release may be obtained if a referral request is denied. Students under 18 must have a parent or legal guardian to sign referral/release forms.

David Douglas (John Murray, 503-261-8341) & Fir Ridge (Catherine Nyhan, 503-256-6530): Students must go to the school in order to get a referral. A release may be obtained if a referral request is denied. Students under 18 must have a parent or legal guardian to sign referral/release forms.

Parkrose (503-408-2600): Students under 18 must have a parent or legal guardian to sign referral/release forms.

Reynolds High School (Laura Goodrick 503-667-3186 ext. 1057) or Reynolds Learning Academy (Terry Chellis, 503-667-4673) Referrals are only given to students 16-20. If students live in the Reynolds district, they must contact Reynolds Learning Academy in order to determine if a referral may be obtained. They will need to go to Reynolds Learning Academy (RLA) to obtain the actual referral, even if they previously attended, or would attend, Reynolds High School. Students under 18 must have a parent or legal guardian to sign referral forms.

Sandy High School (503-668-8011): All students 16-20 must go to the school in order to get a referral. A release may be obtained if a referral request is denied. Students under 18 must have a parent or legal guardian to sign referral forms.

Springwater Trail High School (Sue Weflen, 503-667-3697): All students 16-20 must go to the school in order to get a referral. A release may be obtained if a referral request is denied. Students under 18 must have a parent or legal guardian to sign referral forms.
