

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN

And





Linfield College

- I. This articulation agreement is entered into by MT. HOOD COMMUNITY COLLEGE Nursing Program, hereinafter referred to as MHCC, and LINFIELD COLLEGE, an Oregon nonprofit corporation, hereinafter referred to as LINFIELD.
- II. It is agreed that students transferring from MHCC to the LINFIELD RN to BSN program upon completion of their associate degree will be given full credit for all selected courses in the Course Selection Guide attached hereto as Ex. A and by this reference incorporated herein.

First baccalaureate seeking students at LINFIELD must complete a minimum of 30 semester credits of LINFIELD course work before a degree will be awarded. Second baccalaureate seeking students must complete a minimum of 35 semester credits of LINFIELD course work before a degree will be awarded.

Courses required for graduation will be identified based upon a Transfer Credit Evaluation received by the RN to BSN student upon admission to LINFIELD, as determined under the LINFIELD Catalog in effect during the year of admission. Students will be expected to register for LINFIELD courses within one year after graduating from MHCC and maintain satisfactory academic progress toward graduation.

- III. This articulation agreement is based on the evaluation of the rigor and content of the general education and nursing courses at both MHCC and LINFIELD, and will remain in effect from academic year 2016-2017 until June 30, 2019. In the event that substantive curriculum changes occur at either college, a new credit overview document will be submitted as an addendum to agreement.
- IV. This agreement is effective as of the date of the last signature below.
