

# ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

## Mt. Hood Community College

## Pacific University

## Department of Music

Pacific University (PU) and Mt. Hood Community College (MHCC) will cooperate to promote successful undergraduate education experiences for students who wish to attend both institutions. This cooperative partnership is designed to further reduce barriers, promote smooth transitions between institutions and departments, and to assure that student success is optimized through early identification and support. Participants will have increased curricular choices and better opportunities to tailor their educational experiences to fit personal goals, preferences, and timelines.

### Agreement Articulation and Advising

- In accordance with our general Articulation Agreement with Mt. Hood Community College, Pacific University will accept in transfer most college level course credits that are not technical/vocational credits. In addition, by prior approval of the Music Department with this articulation, Pacific University will accept the courses listed below from Mt. Hood Community College Music Department will give credit for the courses as listed below upon admission into the university.

Applied music students will be evaluated by faculty in each area of discipline to determine the appropriate lesson level on a case by case basis.	

- The management of partnership and resulting articulation agreements between the two institutions will be coordinated through the Office of Academic Affairs at Pacific University and the Vice President of Academic and Student Affairs at Mt. Hood Community College.
- Academic advising will be a shared responsibility with involvement of the Advising Center and Faculty Advisors at Pacific University and advisors from Mt Hood Community College.

### Terms and Termination

- The term of this agreement shall remain effective until one institution provides written notice of termination no less than 90 days prior to the intent to terminate. This must be provided in writing to the institution's President or Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs/Vice President of Instruction.
- Amendments to this agreement must be in writing and approved by the President or Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs/Vice President of Instruction. No amendment can lengthen the term of this agreement.
- This agreement can be terminated at any time by the mutual written agreement of the institutions' presidents.
