Thank you for submitting your application for emergency relief funds! Please review the following details and important next steps.

What are these funds? Under the American Rescue Plan, colleges have been given emergency relief funds (also known as Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds) to help meet the unexpected financial needs of students during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Who is eligible? **ALL active MHCC students are eligible to apply.** The number of credits you take, your financial aid status, or citizenship status do NOT affect eligibility – you simply need to be an MHCC student.

What happens after I apply? Your application will be reviewed within one week (or sooner) after we receive it. You will receive another email when you have been awarded. Since these are emergency grants, the money will go directly to you through your refund option with BankMobile. If you are not familiar with BankMobile, you will receive more information once you are awarded. These funds will not be applied to any student account balance with the college. You can use the money as you see fit.

How much will I get? Award amounts will be different for every student based on the application, but the minimum award per student will be \$200 and the maximum will be \$1000 for the term.
