- The Surgical Technology program is a limited entry program.
- Currently, we admit 20- 24 students for a Fall term start with a waitlist of 10.



PROGRAM DETAILS

- Length: 2 years (6 terms) Full-time attendance
- Degree: Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in Surgical Technology
- Credential: National Certification (CST)
 - Certification Exam completed/ passed prior to Graduation
- Accreditation: Program accredited since 1978 by Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP).
 - The program follows core curriculum in collaboration with Accreditation Review Council on education in Surgical Technology and Surgical Assisting (ARC/STSA), and the Association of Surgical Technology (AST).

 - BI234 Microbiology (Completed by Winter Term or Registered to Complete by Spring Term of Application Cycle)
- Written Exercise: Surgical Technology Job Description (3 parts)
- Online Application Submission and Application Fee

• Interview and Proctored Essay
